- Pakistan's top imports mostly consisted of flat rolled products of iron and steel, cotton and kidney beans. India's top imports consisted of petroleum products, coal, chemicals including urea, potassium chloride etc., and silver.
- Petroleum oils constituted more than half of India's aggregate imports from 2020 to 2024.

- Almost all of Pakistan's top exports to the Central Asian Republics constituted agricultural products including rice, sesamum seeds and fruits. Other top exports included frozen bovine carcasses and medicaments.
- Comparatively, India's top exports to the Central Asian Republics constituted a greater proportion of value-added items, including medicaments, smartphones, telephones, vaccines, and tractor parts.

- Pakistan's aggregate trade with the Central Asian republics constituted 0.3% of it's aggregate trade with the world from 2020 to 2024. For India, this percentage was 0.1%.
- For 2020 to 2024, Pakistan held a 0.1% share in the Central Asian Republics' aggregate trade, whilst India held a 0.6% share.
- The trade potential with the Central Asian Republics has been left largely untapped by both countries.

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
