### The European Union

#### 1.1: History of the European Union

The European Union (EU) has its historical origins in the aftermath of World War II when European leaders sought to prevent future conflicts and foster peace and cooperation among European countries. The pivotal moment came with the Schuman Declaration in 1950, proposing the creation of the European Coal and Steel Community (ECSC.)

Subsequent milestones include the Treaty of Rome in 1957, the establishment of the European Economic Community (EEC), and the passing of the Single European Act in 1986, which aimed to remove trade barriers and enhance economic integration. The Maastricht Treaty of 1992 introduced EU citizenship and paved the way for an Economic and Monetary Union (EMU) with the euro being adopted as a common currency.

Over the years, the EU has expanded its membership through various enlargements, notably welcoming countries from Central and Eastern Europe. The Lisbon Treaty in 2007 further reformed the EU's institutional structure to improve decision–making. However, the EU has faced significant challenges in recent times. The UK's decision to leave the EU through Brexit in 2016 marked a significant development. Additionally, the outbreak of the COVID–19 pandemic in 2020 posed an unprecedented crisis, leading to the adoption of Next Generation EU, a recovery plan to support member countries.

#### 1.2: Major Economies of the European Union

Combined, the EU is one of the world's largest economies. The table below lists the top 10 economies of the EU based on gross domestic product (GDP) in 2023. Following Brexit, the UK has not been included in this list.

The EU combined produced \$18.06 trillion worth of goods and services in 2023, accounting for around 17.5 % of the world's output. The following table shows the top 10 economies within the EU, where Germany has the highest GDP of \$4525.7 billion and accounts for 24.3% of the EU economy. Following Germany are France, Italy, Spain, and the Netherlands.

#### 1.3: Recent Developments in the European Union

In recent years, the European Union (EU) has been undergoing significant developments across various spheres, ranging from political, economic, and social issues to global challenges. These developments reflect the EU's commitment to addressing pressing concerns and ensuring a cohesive and prosperous future for its member states and citizens.

One of the most noteworthy developments in the EU was in the aftermath of the Brexit referendum in 2016. After a prolonged and complex negotiation process, the United Kingdom formally left the EU on January 31, 2020. This historic event marked a turning point in the EU's history and triggered a period of adjustment for both the UK and the remaining 27 member states of the EU. The EU has been working to redefine its relationship with the UK, including trade arrangements and cooperation in various areas such as security and research. While formal ties have been recalibrated, much of the ongoing coordination, particularly in foreign policy and sanctions, now occurs through multilateral platforms like the G7 and NATO. This has also been the case with EU–UK alignment on sanctions in response to Russia's war in Ukraine.

Another crucial development that has shaped the EU's recent agenda is the COVID-19 pandemic. The outbreak of the pandemic in 2020 posed an unprecedented challenge for the EU as it confronted a health crises, economic disruptions, and social hardships across the continent. In response, the EU took bold and unprecedented steps to address the crisis collectively. It launched the EU's Recovery and Resilience Facility, a 750-billion-euro fund to support member countries with financial aid to promote economic recovery. This fund, combined with the Next Generation EU program, aims to support various initiatives, including investments in digitalization, green technologies, and healthcare systems, with the goal of building back better and fostering a sustainable and resilient EU economy.

The EU has also demonstrated its commitment to climate action and sustainable development in response to global challenges. The EU aims to become a climate-neutral zone by 2050 and has set ambitious targets for reducing greenhouse gas emissions, promoting renewable energy, and investing in green technologies. The EU's Green Deal, presented in December 2019, is a comprehensive plan that seeks to transform various sectors, including energy, transportation, agriculture, and industry, to create a greener and more sustainable future.

Additionally, the EU has been actively engaged in addressing digital transformation and the regulation of digital technologies. The EU's Digital Single Market strategy aims to foster a digital-first approach in various sectors by promoting digital innovation, e-commerce, and data-driven initiatives while ensuring data protection and privacy for its citizens. Of the top 500 corporations in the world, estimated by revenue in 2024, 90 had their headquarters in the EU.

Following the European Parliament elections in June 2024, the European Commission commenced its 2024–2029 term under the continued leadership of President Ursula von der Leyen and revealed a renewed policy agenda. Around the same time, the European Council adopted the 2024–2029 Strategic Agenda during its Brussels meeting, which set the political and institutional priorities for the EU over the next five years. Chief among these is enhancing the Union's global competitiveness, strengthening security and defence capabilities, and deepening strategic autonomy. Additional focal areas include accelerating the green transition, advancing digital innovation, and undertaking institutional reforms as the EU prepares to absorb new members states.

Heightened geopolitical tensions, including Russia's ongoing war in Ukraine, instability in the Middle East, and growing strategic competition with China, have brought EU Enlargement back into focus. In December 2023, the European Council initiated accession negotiations with Ukraine and Moldova. In parallel, the strategic imperative to integrate the Western Balkans into the EU has gained renewed momentum, as doing so is seen as vital to consolidating regional stability and reinforcing the EU's broader security architecture in the face of external threats.

Regarding foreign policy, the EU has sought to assert itself as a global actor and promote its values and interests on the international stage. The EU has been actively involved in conflict resolution and crisis management efforts in regions like the Western Balkans, the Middle East, and Africa. It has also forged strategic partnerships and maintained dialogues with other global powers to address shared challenges and opportunities.





### Pakistan's Trade with the European Union

Pakistan's history with the European Union (EU) has been marked by cooperation and engagement across trade, development, and political realms. The EU is a significant trading partner for Pakistan, it unilaterally granted Pakistan GSP+ status in 2014, thereby facilitating preferential access to its common market. Pakistan's current GSP+ framework was set to expire on December 31st, 2023, but the EU Parliament voted to extend the current rules for another four years. The GSP+ status which Pakistan currently enjoys will end on December 31st, 2027. Pakistan's GSP+ status is subject to ongoing review by the European Commission, which assesses the country's compliance with 27 international conventions related to human rights, labor rights, environmental protection, and good governance.

#### 2.1: Pakistan-EU Trade

Pakistan's history with the European Union (EU) has evolved over time, marked by periods of cooperation and engagement on various fronts. Formal relations between Pakistan and the EU date back to the early 1970s when the EU recognized Pakistan's strategic importance in South Asia. In 1976, a Cooperation Agreement was signed, laying the foundation for economic and political cooperation. Trade has been a significant aspect of Pakistan-EU relations. In the early 2000s, Pakistan enjoyed preferential trade benefits under the EU's Generalized System of Preferences (GSP). Subsequently, in 2014, Pakistan was granted GSP+ status, a major development that significantly enhanced trade opportunities for Pakistani exporters. The GSP+ has allowed Pakistan to export a wide range of products to the EU market at reduced or zero tariffs, leading to a notable increase in exports, particularly in the textiles and clothing sectors.

The following figure shows Pakistan's trade trends with the EU for the last five years. Over the last five years, Pakistan's trade with the European Union (EU) has seen growth. Total trade between the EU and Pakistan reached \$12.1 billion in 2024, making EU Pakistan's second most important trading partner after China, accounting for approximately 13.6% of Pakistan's total trade. The EU is the most crucial export destination for Pakistan, with 27.6% of the country's exports heading to the European market. Conversely, the EU ranks as Pakistan's sixth-largest import source, with imports of \$3.2 billion in 2024.

The GSP+ scheme has facilitated Pakistan's exports to the EU, with zero import duties applied to 66 percent tariff lines. As a result, Pakistan's exports to the EU have consistently increased over the years, rising from \$5.1 billion in 2015 to \$9.0 billion in 2024, making it the largest beneficiary among all GSP+ countries.

About 78.7% of EU imports from Pakistan are imported using GSP+ preferential tariffs, showcasing the scheme's significance in promoting trade. The current preference utilization rate, representing the ratio of preferential imports to GSP+ eligible imports, stands at an impressive 87.9%.




Figure 1: Pakistan's Trade Trends with the EU




Figure 1: Pakistan Austria Trade Trend







Figure 3: Pakistan-Bulgaria Trade Trends







Figure 4: Pakistan - Cyprus Trade-Trend





Figure 5: Pakistan - Czech Republic Trade Trend





Table 26: Pakistan - Denmark Trade Trend









Figure 8: Pakistan - France Trade Trends





Figure 9: Pakistan - Germany Trade Trends








Figure 12: Pakistan - Ireland Trade Trend





Figure 13: Pakistan – Italy Trade Trend





Figure 14: Pakistan - Latvia Trade Trend







Figure 16: Pakistan-Luxembourg Trade Trend





Figure 17: Pakistan - Malta Trade Trend





Figure 18: Pakistan – Netherlands Trade Trend





Figure 19: Pakistan - Poland Trade Trend





Figure 20: Pakistan - Portugal Trade Trend









#### Sweden

Sweden was Pakistan's 34th largest export destination and the 10th largest export destination within the EU in 2024, accounting for 1.9% of total EU exports for Pakistan. It ranked 44th in Pakistan's import sources and within the EU, Sweden was the 9th largest import source in 2024, accounting for 4.4% of imports from the EU. # Trade Discrepancy Between Pakistan and the EU's Reported Trade Data

The trade discrepancy between Pakistan and the EU's reported data is examined here in terms of Pakistan's imports from and exports to the EU and the EU's imports from and exports to Pakistan. The discrepancy is calculated using the formula below:

# Discrepancy = EU's reported Trade with Pakistan – Pakistan's reported Trade with the EU

If the discrepancy is positive, then that represents under-stated imports & exports from Pakistan in comparison to imports & exports from EU. If the discrepancy is negative, then that represents over-reported imports and exports from Pakistan in comparison to imports & exports from EU. The net discrepancy is simply the net value resulting from adding the over and under-stated import/export values.

The tables below list the negative, positive and net discrepancies in Pakistan's reported trade with the EU and the EU's reported trade with Pakistan. Data was aggregated at the HS-06 level for each discrepancy and the past decade was considered.

The table below lists the discrepancies in Pakistan's reported imports from the EU.

The net discrepancy in imports seems to hold fairly steady through the decade, rising to a maximum of \$842.1 million in 2021, before falling to \$745.4 million in 2024. The trend of the under and over-stated imports seem to mirror each other, rising and falling in tandem throughout the years.



The net discrepancy in reported exports to the EU has steadily risen through the decade, from a low of \$958.3 million in 2015 to \$2,128.3 million in 2024. The magnitudes of the over and under-stated exports has also risen in tandem through the decade.
