



- Imports from Africa represented 5.8% of all imports in 2024, and 5.9% of all imports from 2020 to 2024.
- Pakistan held a 0.6% share in Africa's aggregate exports from 2020 to 2024.
- The top ten import sources represented 88.3% of all imports from Africa between 2020 & 2024 and were valued at 15,372.3 USD Million.





Figure 3: Pakistan's top imports at HS-02 from 2020-2024 Aggregate and their import Value (USD Million)



- The largest import category, Mineral fuels, oils and products of distillation, featured 6,889.2 USD Million worth of imports from 2020 to 2024. Bituminous coal and liquified natural gas made up the majority of this category's import value at 4,505.8 USD Million and 2,166.9, respectively.
- Other top categories were Tea and Spices, Cotton, Chemicals (mostly comprising phosphates) and Oil Seeds.

- India's aggregate import value over the given period is considerably larger than Pakistan's, at 201,310.4 USD Million against 17,421.7 USD Million, respectively.
- Top imports for most countries are similar, comprising of hydrocarbons, phosphates, copper, and agricultural products.
- One notable difference is India's imports of unworked diamonds which the country processes by cutting before proceeding to export.



- Exports to Africa represented 7.4% of all exports in 2024, and 6.0% of all exports from 2020 to 2024.
- Pakistan's share in Africa's aggregate imports was 0.3% from 2020 to 2024.
- The top ten export destinations represented 71.7% of all exports to Africa, between 2020 & 2024, at 6,176.0 USD Million

 Rice is the top export category, along with textiles and cotton. These three categories constituted more than half of all aggregate exports to Africa from 2020 to 2024.



- India's total trade with Africa eclipses Pakistan's trade, with the former holding a 6.7% share in Africa's aggregate trade from 2020 to 2024.
- Sub-Saharan Africa seems to have particularly strong trade links with India, with South Africa and Nigeria being two of India's largest African trading partners by far.
